Seethalakshmi Ramaswami College (SRC) has helped to educate and empower generations of women who are now successfully dispersed throughout the world. At a time when education of women was frowned upon, our founder had the courage and conviction to provide school and college education to girls in the backdrop of Indian values and culture. To this day, our college rigorously follows the founding ideals by providing affordable education to girls from disadvantaged economic and social backgrounds. Since the founder's demise in 1976, the college has been managed and enhanced by his son **Sri R.Panchapakesan**, who serves as the Managing Trustee. He is ably assisted by his son **Dr.Kannan Panchapakesan**, a Ph.D. in Electrical Engineering.



ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS

Seethalakshmi Ramaswami College offers 25 U.G. programmes, 09 P.G. programmes and 8 Ph.D. programmes. With 4500 students and 200 faculty members, SRC is a force to be reckoned with in women's education today. SRC was one of the first colleges in Tiruchirappalli area to opt for autonomous status in the year 1987. Another first to its credit is that SRC happened to be one of the first 7 colleges in the country to be accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in 1999. This has allowed us to experiment and innovate in curricular aspects. The college has come to be recognized as a pioneer in designing and offering new programmes. For example, Bio-technology, Electronics, Hospital Administration, Commerce Applied, Nutrition & Dietetics are some of the innovative programmes that drew the attention of peer institutions and prospective students at the time of their introduction. **Outcome Based Education (OBE)** with **Choice Based Credit System (CBCS)** has led to the enhancement of the professional, vocational, intellectual and inter-personal skills of the students.

NAAC

In the assessment by NAAC, the college has been accredited with an “A+” grade in recognition of its all-round academic excellence, research programmes, and social outreach activities.

INFRASTRUCTURE

In order to provide a nurturing learning environment, it is essential to make sure that the infrastructure of the college keeps pace with the latest developments in the various relevant areas. Some of the highlights from recent years include:

- ◆ **Sri Saraswathi Block** : This 3-storey edifice houses a spacious, modern and fully-automated library, a commodious reading room, 3 seminar halls, a PC-based English language laboratory and an internet-enabled computer center with 300 Computers.

- ◆ **Manicka Vinayagar Open-Air Theatre** : A massive outdoor auditorium can accommodate the entire student population of the college.

- ◆ **Akilandeswari Auditorium** : A huge closed auditorium capable of accommodating more than 1500 audience.

- ◆ **Seminar Halls** : There are six well-equipped seminar halls namely Vidya Ganapathy Hall, Seethalakshmi Hall, Medha Saraswathi Hall, Mookambika Hall, Bhagavathi Hall and Annapoorna Hall. All the halls are designed with state-of-the-art technology to enhance the teaching and learning experience.

- ◆ **Multimedia Hall** : The lectures and programmes designed under the Swayam Prabha scheme of MHRD are telecast in the Multimedia Hall to ensure that the students are sensitized to the recent developments in their field of study.

- ◆ **E-Studio** : E-Studio has the state-of-the art infrastructure. Faculty members develop e-teaching and learning materials using Eye RIS software, through which students gain knowledge in upcoming and current fields of study.

- ◆ **Smart Classroom** : Smart classrooms provide opportunities for teaching and learning by combining learning technologies, audio-visual tools and internet facility.

- ◆ **Library** : A well equipped Central Library around 7000 Square Feet houses 92058 books, journals and e-resources

- ◆ **Students' Study Centre** : Aspirants of UPSC, TNPSC and other competitive examinations prepare at the Study centre, during their leisure time. It houses around 250 books for various competitive examinations

- ◆ **Athletics Track** : A 8-lane athletic track with an expansive sports area in the middle has been developed to cater to track and field events.

- ◆ **Gymnasium** : Nearly 400 students benefit from using the facility regularly. It helps them keep physically fit and healthy.

- ◆ **First-Aid Room** : Caters to immediate first-aid treatment of faculty, staff and students.

- ◆ **Water and Sanitation** : Several water purifiers have been installed around the campus to provide safe hot / cold drinking water. New toilets have been constructed and older toilets rebuilt to promote proper health and hygiene of the students.

- ◆ **Bank with ATM** : A branch of Canara Bank functions inside the college campus. The banking services and ATM facilities are available on all working days.

PLACEMENT

Our college realizes that one of the top goals of education is to make the students employable and ensure that they succeed in the real world after graduation. Towards this end, the college through its Placement Cell, diligently prepares its students by improving communication and English fluency, imparting essential computer skills, conducting mock interviews and careful career counselling.
